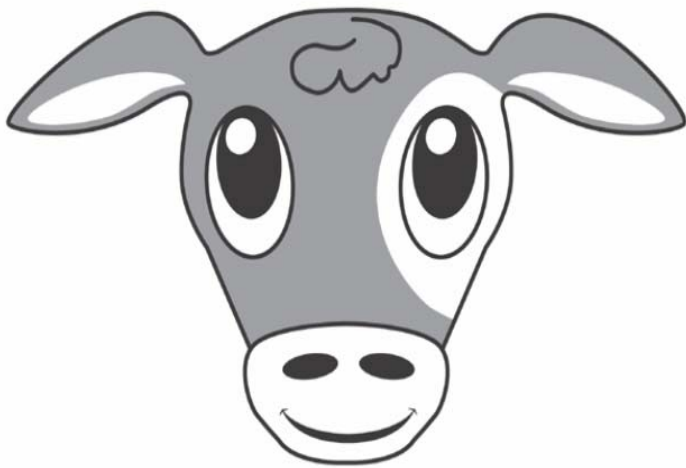
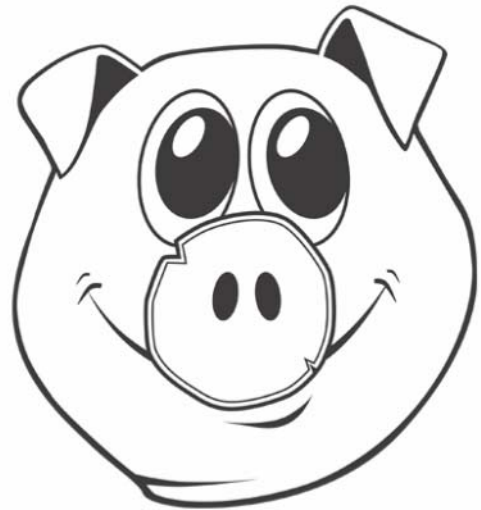


Fun Faces of Wisconsin Agriculture

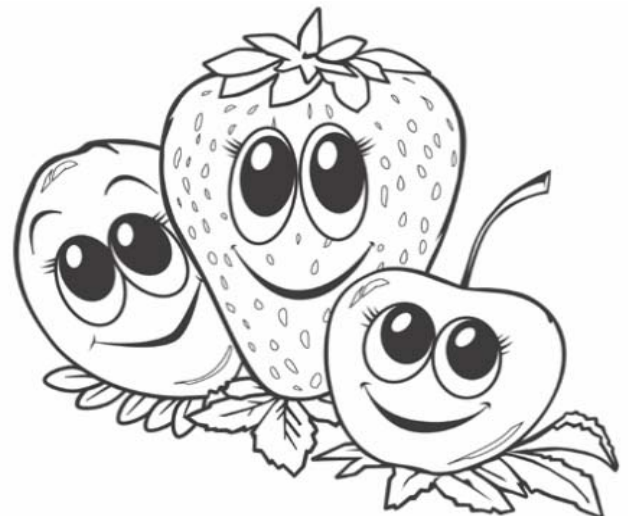
"Porkchop"

"Freddy Fir"

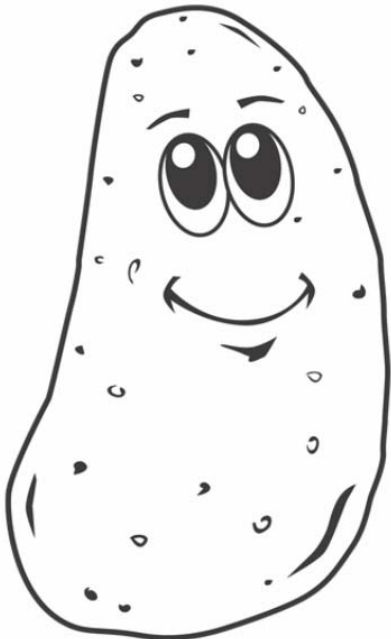

"Berry Bunch"

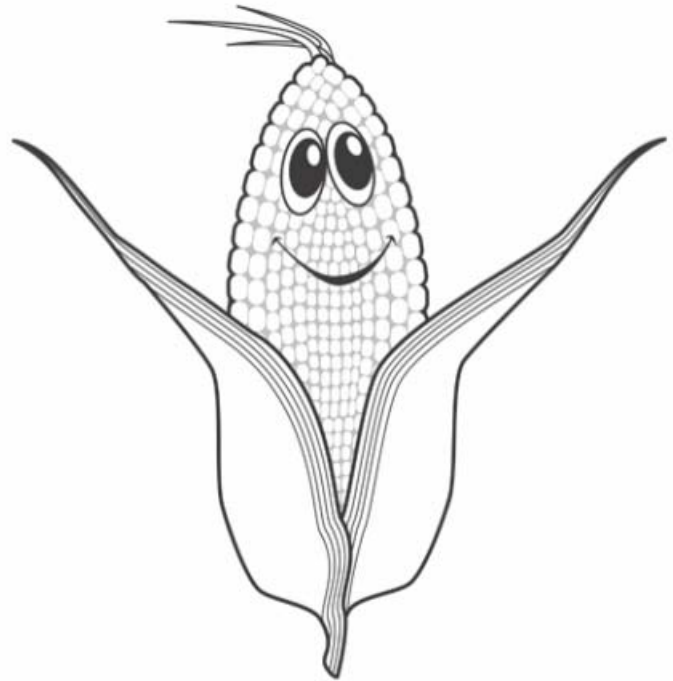

Fun Faces of Wisconsin Agriculture



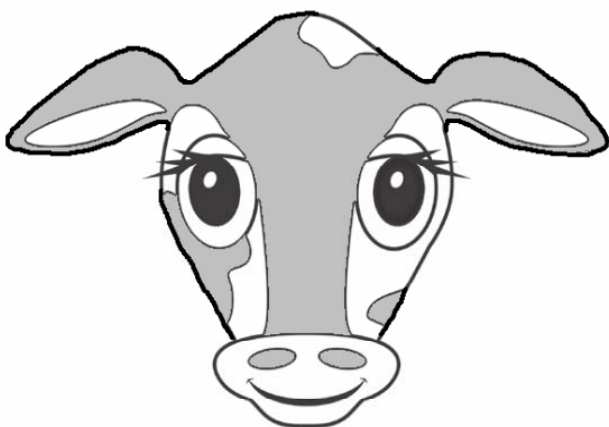
"Spud"

Wisconsin is one of the top vegetable growing states in the nation. We are #1 in snap beans, beets and kraut. We are #2 in peas. We are #3 in sweet corn for processing, carrots and **potatoes**.



"Corny"

Grain production, like oats, **corn**, and soybeans is important for food for humans and cattle, pigs and chicken. Things like dog food, candy, cosmetics, bakery, cereal, oil, fuel, and pharmaceuticals are all products derived from corn.



"Holly Holstein"

Wisconsin **dairy** industry is the biggest part of Wisconsin agriculture. Wisconsin is also one of the best states in cheese and butter production.



"Molly McIntosh"

Each year Wisconsin harvests 68 million pounds of crisp, juicy **apples**. Orchards around the state grow enough apples to make 40 million apple pies.
