## Fast Facts

- Wisconsin ranks 4<sup>th</sup> in maple syrup production.
- The Sugar Maple is the Wisconsin state tree.
- 40 gallons of sap makes 1 gallon of syrup.
- Harvest season lasts **4-6** weeks.

Maple Syrup Making

- 1. Wait until **freezing rights** and mild days.
- 2. Find a tree 10 inches in diameter.
- 3. Drill a hole  $\frac{7}{16}$  unches wide and **3** unches deep.
- 4. Insert a spile.
- 5. Attach a collecting bucket.
- 6. Collect the sap and place in an evaporation pan and heat to  $219^{\circ}$ F.
- 7. Filter the syrup, bottle and label.

## How the sap flows

Sap flow from sugar maples is an entirely temperature dependent process. How it works:
